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To whom it may concern:

The Logan Twp. Police Dept. received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on 02FEB2026. This response to your request is being provided to you on the first business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

Records Requested:

1. A complete copy of the traffic ticket/summons issued #002608.
2. All police reports and investigation reports associated with this ticket.
3. All officers' notes, reports, supplements, and incident logs related to this ticket.
4. All video footage, body-worn camera recordings, dash camera recordings, surveillance video, and any other audiovisual recordings connected to this matter.
5. Any and all photographs or evidence files associated with this incident.

Response:

Your request is denied for the following reason(s):

- The request is overly broad.
- The request does not identify a timeframe.
- The request requires research.

Additional Information:

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7)

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business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Logan Township Police Department to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
