1. OPERATION OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE

ON APRIL 14, 2016 AT APPROXIMATELY 2213 HOURS, I WAS TRAVELING EASTBOUND ON MOUNTAIN BOULEVARD EXTENSION IN MARKED PATROL VEHICLE #83. AS I CONTINUED EASTBOUND, I OBSERVED A SILVER TOYOTA 4RUNNER BEARING NEW JERSEY REGISTRATION [REDACTED] TRAVELING WESTBOUND WITH ITS HIGH BEAMS ON AS ONCOMING TRAFFIC APPROACHED. I SUBSEQUENTLY MADE A U-TURN AND BEGAN FOLLOWING THE SUSPECT VEHICLE AS IT CONTINUED WEST ONTO WASHINGTON VALLEY ROAD. WHILE BEHIND THE SUSPECT VEHICLE I OBSERVED THE DRIVER FAIL TO MAINTAIN ITS LANE AS IT APPROACHED TOP OF THE WORLD WAY WITH HALF OF THE VEHICLE TRAVELING IN THE TURN ONLY LANE FOR TOP OF THE WORLD WAY. I THEN BEGAN TO CLOSE THE DISTANCE BETWEEN MY PATROL CAR AND THE SUSPECT VEHICLE AND FURTHER OBSERVED THE SUSPECT VEHICLE HAD A CRACKED WINDSHIELD. AT THAT TIME I INITIATED A MOTOR VEHICLE STOP BY ACTIVATING MY EMERGENCY LIGHTS. THE SUSPECT VEHICLE CAME TO A STOP ON THE RIGHT SHOULDER OF WASHINGTON VALLEY ROAD NEAR QUAIL RUN CENTER.

2. ONCE STOPPED

I EXITED MY PATROL VEHICLE AND MADE A DRIVER'S SIDE APPROACH ON THE SUSPECT VEHICLE. UPON REACHING THE OPEN DRIVER'S SIDE WINDOW I IDENTIFIED MYSELF AND ASKED THE DRIVER, LATER IDENTIFIED AS LISA LONTAI, FOR HER DRIVER'S LICENSE, VEHICLE REGISTRATION, AND INSURANCE CARD. WHILE WAITING FOR LONTAI TO GATHER HER DOCUMENTS, I DETECTED THE STRONG ODOR OF AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE EMANATING FROM THE INTERIOR OF THE VEHICLE. I FURTHER OBSERVED LONTAI'S EYES WERE WATERY AND HER EYELIDS WERE DROOPY AS SHE PROVIDED ME WITH HER DOCUMENTS. I THEN ADVISED LONTAI SOME OF THE REASONS FOR THE STOP AND ASKED HER IF SHE HAS CONSUMED ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO WHICH SHE SAID YES. I THEN ASKED FOR AN ADDITIONAL UNIT TO RESPOND TO MY LOCATION AND RETURNED TO MY PATROL VEHICLE WHERE I TURNED OFF THE FORWARD FACING EMERGENCY LIGHTS. I THEN RETURNED TO THE SUSPECT'S VEHICLE AND CONFIRMED LONTAI WAS CAPABLE OF RECITING THE ENGLISH ALPHABET (MASTER'S DEGREE) AND ADVISED HER I WANTED HER TO RECITE THE ENGLISH ALPHABET STARTING WITH THE LETTER "E" AS IN ECHO AND TO STOP AT THE LETTER "X" AS IN X-RAY WITHOUT SINGING IT. AFTER EXPLAINING AND CONFIRMING LONTAI UNDERSTOOD THE TEST, LONTAI PROCEEDED TO RECITE THE ALPHABET BUT FAILED TO STOP AT THE LETTER "X" AS INSTRUCTED AND CONTINUED TO THE LETTER "Z". I THEN EXPLAINED AND DEMONSTRATED THE FINGER DEXTERITY TEST TO LONTAI AND HAD HER PERFORM THE TEST WHICH SHE SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED.

AFTER LONTAI COMPLETED THE FINGER DEXTERITY TEST, I ASKED HER TO EXIT HER VEHICLE AND TO WALK TO THE FRONT OF IT SO I COULD HAVE HER PERFORM ADDITIONAL TESTS. LONTAI COMPLIED WITHOUT INCIDENT. ONCE IN FRONT OF THE SUSPECT VEHICLE, I CONFIRMED WITH LONTAI SHE DID NOT HAVE ANY PROBLEMS WITH HER EYES ASIDE FROM BEING NEARSIGHTED AND PROVIDED HER WITH INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO PERFORM THE HORIZONTAL GAZE NYSTAGMUS (HGN) TEST. AFTER EXPLAINING THE TEST, LONTAI CONFIRMED SHE UNDERSTOOD THE TEST. UTILIZING MY RIGHT INDEX FINGER AS THE STIMULUS, I BEGAN THE TEST BY OBSERVING LONTAI'S PUPILS SIZES WERE THE SAME AND SHE HAD EQUAL TRACKING. WHILE CONDUCTING THE TEST ON LONTAI, I OBSERVED A LACK OF SMOOTH PURSUIT IN BOTH HER LEFT AND RIGHT EYES AND DISTINCT AND SUSTAINED NYSTAGMUS AT MAXIMUM DEVIATION IN BOTH HER LEFT AND RIGHT EYES. IT SHOULD BE NOTED, I DID NOT OBSERVE THE ONSET OF NYSTAGMUS PRIOR TO 45 DEGREES NOR VERTICAL GAZE NYSTAGMUS IN EITHER EYE.

AFTER COMPLETING THE HORIZONTAL GAZE NYSTAGMUS TEST, I EXPLAINED AND DEMONSTRATED THE STARTING POSITION FOR THE WALK AND TURN TEST. I THEN ASKED LONTAI TO GET INTO THE STARTING POSITION FOR THE TEST WHICH SHE DID SUCCESSFULLY. ONCE LONTAI WAS IN THE STARTING POSITION, I EXPLAINED AND DEMONSTRATED THE TEST. DURING MY EXPLANATION AND DEMONSTRATION OF THE TEST, LONTAI HAD TO SEPARATE HER FEET FOR BALANCE AND I INSTRUCTED HER TO RETURN TO THE STARTING POSITION WHICH SHE DID SUCCESSFULLY. AFTER I FINISHED EXPLAINING AND DEMONSTRATING THE TEST, I CONFIRMED WITH LONTAI SHE UNDERSTOOD THE TEST AND TOLD HER SHE COULD BEGIN. DURING LONTAI'S INITIAL 9 STEPS, SHE FAILED TO TOUCH HER HEEL TO HER TOE ON STEP 3 AND LOST HER BALANCE AS SHE TOOK STEP 5 WHICH CAUSED HER TO RAISE HER ARMS APPROXIMATELY 20 INCHES FROM HER SIDES AND STOP TO REGAIN HER BALANCE. LONTAI ALSO FAILED TO TAKE THE CORRECT NUMBER OF STEPS BY TAKING A TOTAL OF 10 STEPS INSTEAD OF 9 AS INSTRUCTED. AFTER TAKING HER 10TH STEP, LONTAI FAILED TO TURN AS INSTRUCTED BY MOVING BOTH HER FEET AT THE SAME TIME AS SHE TURNED. DURING LONTAI'S...

1. You have been arrested for operating a commercial motor vehicle with an alcohol concentration of 0.04% or more.
2. You are required by law to submit to the taking of samples of your breath for the purposes of making chemical tests to determine your alcohol concentration.
3. A record of the taking of the samples, including the date, time and results, will be made. Upon your request, a copy of that record will be made available to you.
4. Any warnings previously given to you concerning your right to remain silent and your right to consult with an attorney do not apply to the taking of breath samples and do not give you the right to refuse to give, or to delay giving, samples of your breath for the purposes of making chemical tests to determine your alcohol concentration. 7. Any response that is ambiguous or conditional, in any respect, to your giving consent to the taking of breath samples will be treated as a refusal to submit to breath testing.
8. According to N.J.S.A. 39:3-10.24f, if a court of law finds you guilty of refusing to submit to chemical tests of your breath, then your license to operate any motor vehicle will be revoked by the court for a period of no less than six months and no more than two years. The Court will also fine you a sum of no less than \$250 and no more than \$500 for your refusal conviction.
9. If a court of law finds you guilty of refusing to submit to chemical tests of your breath, and you were operating a commercial motor vehicle, then your commercial driver license will be suspended by the court for a period of no less than one and no more than three years. 10. Any license suspension or revocation for a refusal conviction will be independent to any license suspension or revocation imposed for any related offense.
11. If you are convicted of refusing to submit to chemical tests of your breath, you must also satisfy the requirements of a program of alcohol education or rehabilitation.
12. I repeat, you are required by law to submit to the taking of samples of your breath for the purpose of making chemical tests to determine your alcohol concentration. Now, will you give the samples of your breath?

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9 RETURN STEPS SHE FAILED TO TOUCH HEEL TO TOE ON STEPS 7 AND 8.

NEXT, I EXPLAINED AND DEMONSTRATED THE STARTING POSITION FOR THE ONE LEG STAND TEST. LONTAI SUCCESSFULLY GOT INTO THE STARTING POSITION FOR THE TEST. I THEN EXPLAINED AND DEMONSTRATED THE TEST AND CONFIRMED WITH LONTAI THAT SHE UNDERSTOOD THE TEST. LONTAI THEN BEGAN THE TEST BY RAISING HER RIGHT FOOT AND IMMEDIATELY BEGAN SWAYING BACK AND FORTH APPROXIMATELY 10 INCHES SIDE TO SIDE. LONTAI THEN PLACED HER FOOT DOWN AS SHE COUNTED ONE THOUSAND AND THREE. I INSTRUCTED HER TO PICK HER FOOT BACK UP AND TO CONTINUE COUNTING. LONTAI AGAIN RAISED HER RIGHT FOOT AND BEGAN SWAYING UNTIL SHE PLACED HER FOOT DOWN AGAIN AT 14 ONE THOUSAND. WHILE TRANSPORTING LONTAI TO POLICE HEADQUARTERS, I DETECTED THE ODOR OF AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE EMANATING FROM THE REAR OF MY PATROL VEHICLE WHERE LONTAI WAS SEATED.

4. AT THE STATION

AT POLICE HEADQUARTERS, LONTAI WAS SECURED IN THE PROCESSING ROOM AND I REMOVED ALL PORTABLE ELECTRONIC DEVICES FROM THE ROOM. I THEN ASKED LONTAI TO OPEN HER MOUTH AND LIFT HER TONGUE TO ENSURE THAT HER MOUTH WAS FREE OF ANY FOREIGN OBJECTS. AFTER OBSERVING SOME YELLOW RESIDUE ON LONTAI'S TONGUE I PROVIDED HER WITH A CUP OF WATER AND HAD HER RINSE HER MOUTH. I THEN AGAIN INSTRUCTED HER TO OPEN HER MOUTH AND LIFT HER TONGUE AND CONFIRMED HER MOUTH WAS FREE OF ANY FOREIGN OBJECTS. AT THAT TIME, I BEGAN MY DIRECT OBSERVATION PERIOD AT 2242 HOURS. IT SHOULD BE NOTED, THE TIMES OF THE DIRECT OBSERVATION PERIOD WERE NOTED BY ACCESSING THE TIME FUNCTION IN THE ALCOTEST 7110 MKIII-C INSTRUMENT (REDACTED). DURING THIS TIME, I READ THE NEW JERSEY ATTORNEY GENERAL'S STANDARD STATEMENT FOR MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATORS. AFTER READING LINE NUMBER 9 LONTAI AGREED TO PROVIDE SAMPLES OF HER BREATH. I ALSO ADVISED LONTAI OF HER CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS UTILIZING A SOMERSET COUNTY PROSECUTORS OFFICE CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS AND WAIVER FORM. (EVIDENCE #JS-1). LONTAI STATED SHE UNDERSTOOD EACH OF HER RIGHTS, INITIALLED AND SIGNED THE FORM INDICATING THE SAME AND AGREED TO ANSWER QUESTIONS. POST MIRANDA, LONTAI STATED SHE STARTED DRINKING AT APPROXIMATELY 1930 HOURS AT THE DELICIOUS HEIGHTS (BERKELEY HEIGHTS) RESTAURANT WHEN SHE HAD A BELVEDERE MARTINI MARTINI STRAIGHT UP WITH A TWIST WHICH CONTAINED ICE CUBES. WHILE CONSUMING HER DRINK SHE HAD SMALL PORTIONS OF SEVERAL APPETIZERS AND DESSERT (CHICKEN WING, SPARE RIB, SUSHI, CHICKEN WRAP, PISTACHIO ICE CREAM AND A BITE OF CHOCOLATE CAKE). LONTAI FURTHER STATED AFTER SHE FINISHED HER MARTINI SHE DRANK A GLASS OF WATER AND THEN CONSUMED A LEMON DROP MIXED DRINK CONTAINING VODKA AND FINISHED IT AT APPROXIMATELY 2115 HOURS.

AFTER SATISFYING THE 20 MINUTE DIRECT OBSERVATION PERIOD, I BEGAN PREPARING THE INSTRUMENT BY ENTERING THE APPROPRIATE INFORMATION. I THEN ADVISED LONTAI ON HOW TO PROVIDE BREATH SAMPLES WHICH SHE STATED SHE UNDERSTOOD. LONTAI THEN PROVIDED BREATH SAMPLES WHICH PRODUCED AN ALCOHOL INFLUENCE REPORT ON THREE SEPARATE OCCASIONS BUT EACH TIME A CHECK OF THE BREATH SAMPLES PROVIDED BY LONTAI WAS NOT DEEMED TO BE WITHIN AN ACCEPTABLE TOLERANCE BY THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY ALCOTEST CALCULATOR. IT SHOULD BE NOTED, I MAINTAINED DIRECT OBSERVATION OF LONTAI UNTIL THE THIRD ALCOHOL INFLUENCE REPORT WAS GENERATED. AFTER UNSUCCESSFULLY OBTAINING GOOD BREATH SAMPLES UTILIZING OUR INSTRUMENT, I TRANSPORTED LONTAI TO THE WATCHUNG POLICE DEPARTMENT TO UTILIZE THEIR ALCOTEST INSTRUMENT IN AN EFFORT TO GET GOOD BREATH SAMPLES. ONCE AT THE WATCHUNG POLICE DEPARTMENT, I SECURED LONTAI IN THEIR PROCESSING ROOM AND ASKED LONTAI TO OPEN HER MOUTH AND LIFT HER TONGUE TO ENSURE IT WAS FREE OF ANY FOREIGN OBJECTS. AFTER ENSURING LONTAI'S MOUTH WAS CLEAR, I BEGAN THE 20 MINUTES OF DIRECT OBSERVATION AT 0004 HOURS. THE TIMES OF THE DIRECT OBSERVATION AGAIN WERE DETERMINED BY ACCESSING THE TIME FUNCTION OF THE ALCOTEST INSTRUMENT (REDACTED). AFTER SATISFYING THE 20 MINUTE DIRECT OBSERVATION PERIOD, I BEGAN PREPARING THE INSTRUMENT BY ENTERING THE APPROPRIATE INFORMATION. I AGAIN ADVISED LONTAI ON HOW TO PROVIDE BREATH SAMPLES WHICH SHE STATED SHE UNDERSTOOD. LONTAI THEN PROVIDED TWO GOOD BREATH SAMPLES WHICH PRODUCED AN ALCOHOL INFLUENCE REPORT. IT SHOULD BE NOTED, AFTER EACH BREATH SAMPLE PROVIDED BY LONTAI A NEW MOUTH PIECE WAS PLACED ON THE INSTRUMENT.

THE TWO BREATH SAMPLES PROVIDED BY LONTAI YIELDED A BLOOD-ALCOHOL READING OF 0.09% WHICH WAS CONFIRMED TO BE WITHIN ACCEPTABLE TOLERANCE BY UTILIZING THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY ALCOTEST CALCULATOR. IT SHOULD BE NOTED, DIRECT OBSERVATION WAS MAINTAINED OF LONTAI AT THE WATCHUNG POLICE DEPARTMENT UNTIL THE TWO SAMPLES WERE CONFIRMED TO BE WITHIN ACCEPTABLE TOLERANCE. I THEN TRANSPORTED LONTAI BACK TO POLICE HEADQUARTERS WITHOUT INCIDENT. AT APPROXIMATELY 0115 HOURS, I PROVIDED PETER LONTAI WITH A COPY OF THE POTENTIAL LIABILITY WARNING FORM. PETER READ THE FORM AND

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STATED HE UNDERSTOOD IT. HE THEN SIGNED THE FORM INDICATING HE RECEIVED THE POTENTIAL LIABILITY WARNING AND WAS PROVIDED WITH THE ORIGINAL. LISA LONTAI WAS SUBSEQUENTLY RELEASED ON HER OWN RECOGNIZANCE TO PETER LONTAI AFTER BEING ISSUED THE BELOW LISTED SUMMONSES.

IT SHOULD BE NOTED, THE MOBILE VIDEO RECORDING (MVR) FROM VEHICLE #83 WAS LATER DOWNLOADED TO A COMPACT DISC AND MARKED INTO EVIDENCE (EVIDENCE #JS-2). THE RECORDING FAILED TO CAPTURE MOST OF THE AUDIO DUE TO THE PORTABLE MICROPHONE PACK BEING LOW ON BATTERY. A DRIVING WHILE IMPAIRED - LAST DRINK LOCATION REPORT WAS SENT TO THE NEW JERSEY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL UNIT.
