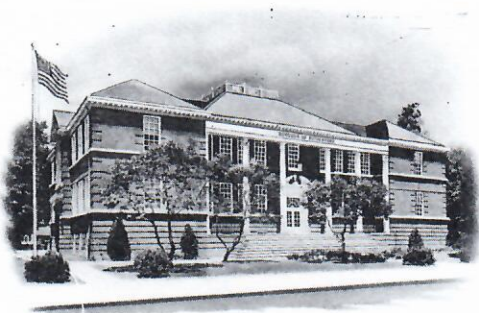

In response to your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request received on the above referenced date, same is being respectfully denied as it is overly broad.

According to the following case law, if an OPRA request does not name specifically identifiable records or is overly broad, a custodian may deny access pursuant to the following New Jersey court and Government Records Council ("GRC") decisions: *MAG Entertainment, LLC v. Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control*, 375 N.J. Super 534 (App. Div. 2005), *Bent v. Stafford Police Department*, 381 N.J. Super. 30 (App. Div. 2005), *New Jersey Builders Association v. New Jersey Council on Affordable Housing*, 390 N.J. Super. 166 (App. Div. 2007), and *Schuler v. Borough of Bloomsbury*, GRC Complaint No. 2007-151 (February 2009). If you would like to resubmit your request identifying the time frame for the records you are seeking and what is meant by "pedestrian incidents", we would gladly assist.
