RE: OPRA Request

Dear Steve M:

The South Brunswick Board of Fire Commissioners for the South Brunswick Fire District No. 3 received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on December 27, 2023 at 7:52 p.m. This response is being provided to you on January 4, 2024.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following document: "Produce all training records from the Kingston Volunteer Fire Company for year 2023. Include when the training was done and who was the instructor".

The South Brunswick Fire District No. has no documents responsive to your request.

If you believe that your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at (866) 850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, New Jersey 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in the Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your county.
