Requests: Community Feedback:

***44 Broad Street (received email 11-16-25)**

Tree is leaning toward house, 8" Diameter Hackberry with girdling roots, poor condition, Arborist recommends removal. Inspection made 3-13-26.

Inspection made 3-13-26 of 18" Diameter Elm Tree with Aphids insects in summer, asphalt sidewalk damage, repaired 3x. Pipe damage under sidewalk. Single phase primary overhead. PS has trimmed one side in the past, recommended removal, resident willing to purchase a new tree to be planted in replacement.

***225 Denman Rd (received email 1-25-26)**

Inspection made 3-13-26 of 38" Diameter Pin Oak trunk is solid, 100ft tall, has been trimmed before, resident wants tree cut down. 25' from house on a paper street (Marsh) Crown reduction pruning is recommended by outside vendor, too tall for DPW to reach.

***205 Oak Lane (received email 1-20-26)**

Inspection made on 3-13-26 of 33' Diameter Red Oak in wooded area behind house, Green Acres Property. Tree is declining with 1/3 of base being hollow, tree is 100' tall with house being 60' away. Recommended removal, crane would be needed to do so.

*Sunny Acres Park-Algonquin Drive (email received 2-27-26) Condition of 2 trees requested by a member of the Sunny Acres Group. Inspection made 3-13-26 of 14" Callery Pear and 15" Zelkova. Both are under wires in a small oval grassy patch.

Recommended to plant 4 ornamental Flowering trees – 1 at each point after construction of curbing and signage.

*103 Cummings Street (email 11-04-26)

Inspection made on 3-13-26 of 16" Diameter London Plane which is damaging the sidewalks and wall. Arborist recommends removal when sidewalks are to be replaced, roots were cut when new curb was installed. Will eventually start to damage apron. Lean towards street.

*114 Beech Street (email and visit to TC meeting in January)- Originally filed a Private tree removal request.

Inspection made on 3-13-26 of 32" Diameter Sweet Gum Tree roots are problematic but tree is healthy and appears to be more in front of #116 Beech St, roots are lifting driveway. Recommended trimming and treatment with a treatment to reduce the fruit.

*31 Bloomingdale Ave (email received 2 or 3 times in 2025)

40" Diameter Tulip tree has a solid trunk in fair condition. DPW trimmed what they could in early 2025. John Z, Mike A and myself have made inspections. Sidewalk walkway to front steps is the issue, arborist

recommends driveway to be sealed of the cracking, and sidewalk moved or curved to avoid major root shaving.
