INCIDENT: Property damage (between 2 vehicles)

On Wednesday, 11-28-18, I was dispatched to the above listed address for a property damage report. Upon arrival, I met with the reporting person Ricky Tutella. Mr. Tutella was sitting in his Toms River Municipal owned vehicle, in the Home Town Market parking lot, enjoying his lunch when a vehicle driven Jerry Rodenbaugh, pulled next to him. The driver shut off his vehicle and opened the door, at which point a strong gust of wind caused the door to swing into the rear drivers' side door of the vehicle Mr. Tutella was sitting in.

I observed very minor paint transfer onto Mr. Tutella's vehicle in 3 different spots on the door. I did not observe dents or chipped/cracked paint. Jerry Rodenbaugh was on scene and confirmed that the wind caused his door swing open as he was exiting and strike the township vehicle. There are no reported injuries and no other persons involved. There is no visible damage to Jerry Rodenbaughs vehicle. There were no photo's requested to be taken by Mr. Tutella.
