The Borough of Lawnside received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request seeking the following:

1. Total number of body cameras currently deployed in the police department.
2. Date on which body cameras were deployed to any of the police officers for the first time (year and month).
3. Invoice of body cameras purchase (if body cameras were purchased).

The New Jersey Open Public Records act provides that government records shall be readily accessible for inspection, copying, or examination by the citizens of this State.” NJSA 47:1A-1. Moreover, you have requested an expansive amount of records. As you may be aware, the Borough Hall is closed to the public during this crisis with only essential business carried out by public officials as necessary and as possible. Given the ongoing state of emergency, limited staffing, and general safety concerns, responses to OPRA requests will not be supplied within the standard timeframe, and accordingly, throughout this crisis responses shall be provided as reasonable and practicable. Public safety is of the paramount concern.

We appreciate your patience as we all persevere through this crisis along with the evolving challenges and hurdles that arise.
