Re: Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request – OCPO Table of Organization

Dear Mr. Boero:

This office is in receipt of your request made under the New Jersey Open Public Records Act (OPRA) wherein you are seeking the “latest table of organization for the members of the OCPO to include detectives, civilian personnel, prosecutors and supervisors, their assignments and current roles. Specifically, the latest table of organization since the transfers, retirements and resignations from the OCPO Office of Professional Standards and Corruption Unit.” Please be advised that, as tables of organization contain the names of individual employees, they consist of personnel records that are exempt from disclosure under OPRA, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-10. Additionally, the courts have recognized that prosecutor’s office employees have a special privacy interest because they might be subjected to threats or harm by criminals or suspects. North Jersey Media Group, Inc. v. Bergen County Prosecutor’s Office, 405 N.J. Super. 386, 391 (App. Div. 2009) (citing County of Morris v. Morris Council No. 6, 371 N.J. Super. 246, 260 (App. Div. 2004), *certif. denied*, 182 N.J. 427 (2005).)

Therefore, your request is denied.
