Dear Stockton Faculty 4 Transparency:

Stockton University's Open Public Records Act (OPRA) Custodian received your OPRA Request on August 11, 2021. Except as otherwise stated in the statute, OPRA provides that records are to be made accessible within seven (7) business days, unless they are in storage, archived, or otherwise cannot be made available within that time. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is August 20, 2021.

Your OPRA Request sought access to the following:

This is a request for public records made under OPRA and the common law right of access. I am not required to fill out an official form. Please acknowledge receipt of this message.

Records requested:

- 1. Percentage of Stockton employees that are vaccinated.**
- 2. Percentage of Stockton students that are vaccinated.**

Please include the most up to date percentages as possible and note the date of the data when replying.

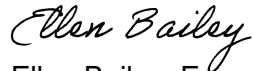

Your OPRA request is invalid because it seeks information and does not identify specific government records. A request that seeks information rather than a specifically identifiable government record is invalid pursuant to MAG Entm't, LLC v. Div. of ABC, 375 N.J. Super. 534, 546 (App. Div. 2005); Bent v. Stafford Police Dep't, 381 N.J. Super. 30, 37 (App. Div. 2005); N.J. Builders Ass'n v. N.J. Council on Affordable Hous., 390 N.J. Super. 166, 180 (App. Div. 2007). "Under OPRA, agencies are required to disclose only 'identifiable' government records not otherwise exempt" MAG, 375 N.J. Super. 546.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied, you have a right to challenge the decision to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council ("GRC") by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511; by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625; by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us; or, at its web site located at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about OPRA. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
