The below pictured subject is Jennifer Coombs ([REDACTED]) of Neptune City. On October 27, she was at the Monmouth County Fire Academy at two separate times. Both times she was walking around the property utilizing her cell phone to live feed the video and her interactions with people on Facebook. During the second time she was at the Fire Academy, Howell officers were called to the scene and she live streamed the interaction with the officers on social media. She was uncooperative and refused to identify herself.

We later learned that she has been doing the same thing at other county and municipal buildings. Be cautious when dealing her, as it appears she is trying to bait officials and officers into encounters with her.

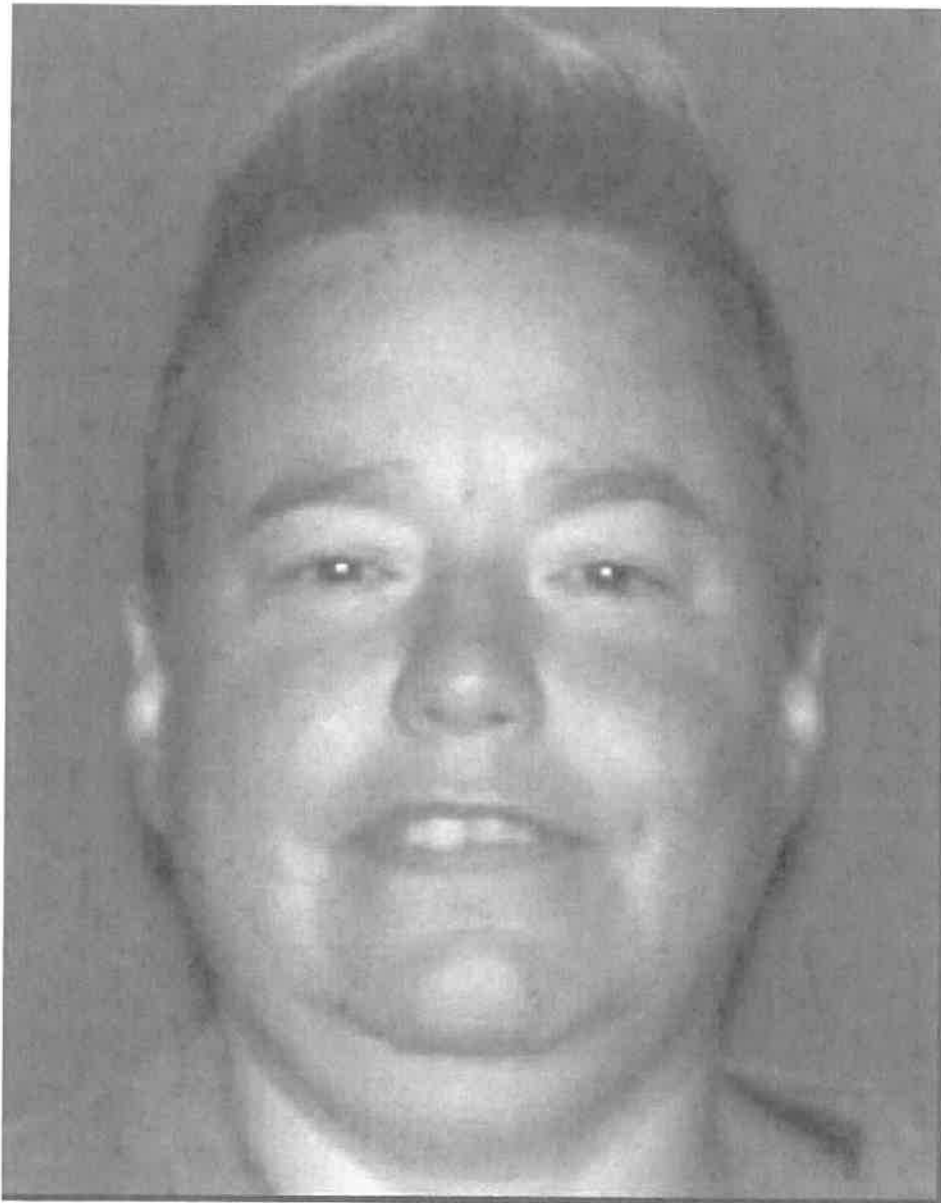

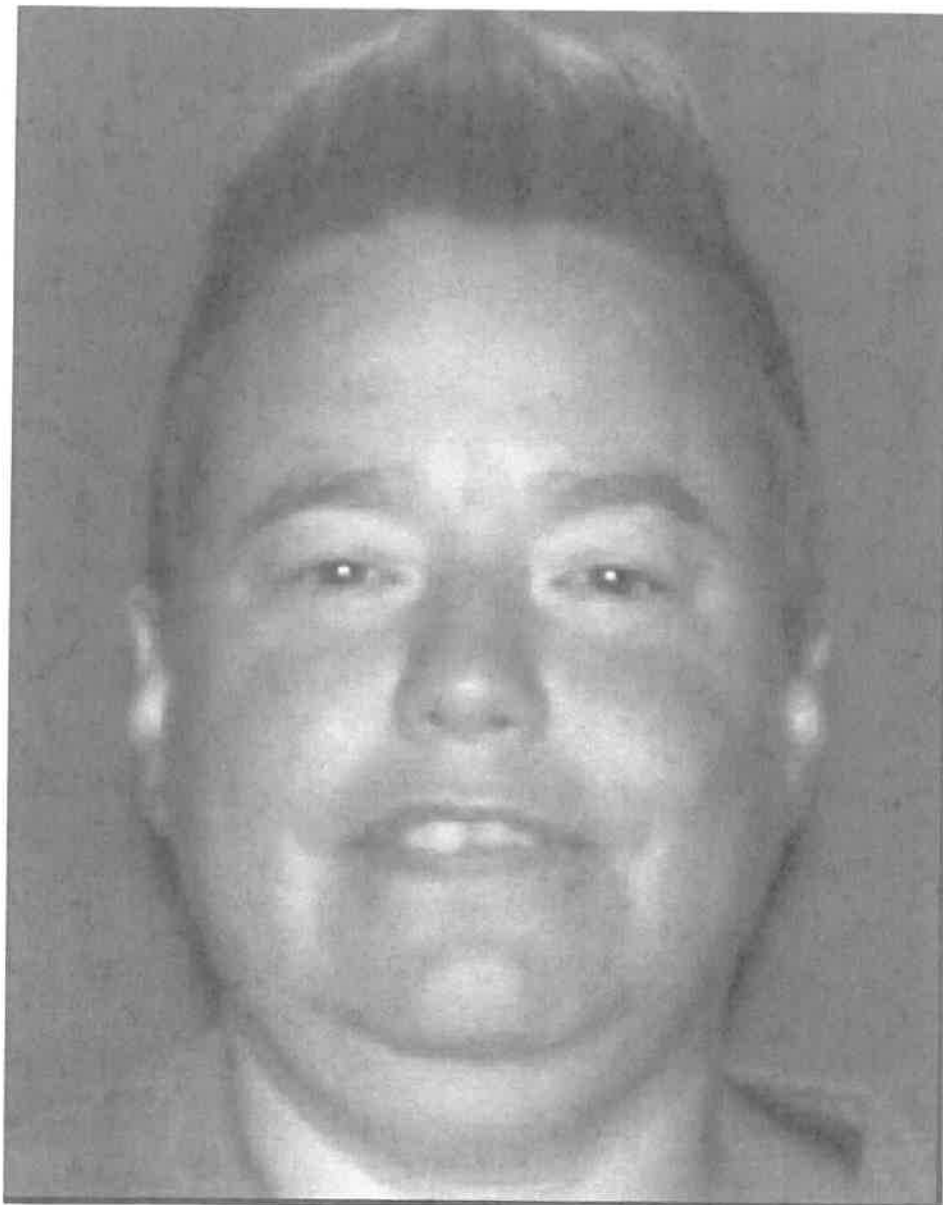

You need to keep this in mind when considering the actions of someone recording. If they are permitted to be where they are, they are permitted to record anything they hear or observe. Unless it's legally posted no audio/video recording a person is permitted to do so regardless how uncomfortable it may make someone. I know it sucks but it's already been decided by the courts.

I'll send you over my public encounters memo I prepared for my personnel.

Also be aware that they regularly OPRA any emails with their names in the subject line.
