The Township of Harrison received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on March 4, 2020. The official Records Custodian, Diane Malloy, received your OPRA request on March 4, 2020. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is March 13, 2020. This response to your request is being provided to you on the [5th] business day after receipt of said request.

The items you requested require research through thousands of emails. We have been working diligently to finish by the deadline, however I have no choice but to request an extension until to March 27, 2020.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Township of Harrison to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form.

The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
