The Borough of Lavallette Custodian of Records, Donnelly Amico, received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request via email on July 26, 2018. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is August 6, 2018. This response to your request is being provided to you on the 5th business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

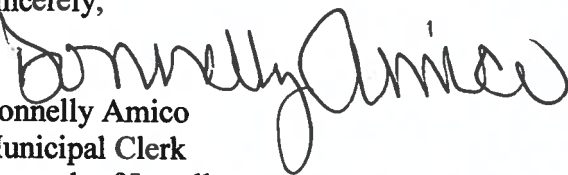
Records request for all records in regards to the accident that occurred at approximately 4:00am on July 25, 2018 at the corner of Route 35S and Reese Avenue.

I have been advised by the Records Clerk from the Lavallette Police Department that the records you have requested will not be ready for distribution until August 10, 2018. As soon as I receive the records, I will forward them to you on or before August 10, 2018. OPRA allows custodians to seek extensions of time pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5i. Specifically, OPRA states that, "the requestor shall be advised by the custodian when the record can be made available. If the record is not made available by that time, access shall be deemed denied."

Your request requires an extension of time until August 10, 2018.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Borough of Lavallette to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
