Narrative:

On the above date and time I, PO. Mark Dunn #252, observed a red Volkswagen Jetta bearing PA registration KSG6178 traveling northbound on West Crescent Avenue. I observed a headlight out on the vehicle. I performed a lookup on the aforementioned registration, which came back to a Jeep. I radioed CO. Anthony Marino #2319 to verify the return. The vehicle then made a right hand turn onto Myrtle Avenue. CO. Marino confirmed the registration did not match the vehicle. I activated the overhead emergency lights on vehicle 219 and conducted a motor vehicle stop, just onto Pittis Avenue. As I approached on foot, the vehicle sped off. I radioed dispatch that the vehicle was taking off on me.

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The vehicle continued east on Pittis Avenue and made a left-hand turn onto Franklin Turnpike traveling northbound. I advised dispatch that the vehicle was a red Volkswagen occupied one time. I observed the vehicle cross over the painted median twice to pass other motor vehicles. I advised Dispatch that I was still attempting to stop the vehicle continuing north on Franklin Turnpike. Speeds were 85 MPH, traffic conditions were light. Let it be known the weather conditions for the night were clear, dry and mild temperatures. A Ramsey PD unit pulled in front of me as we were entering their jurisdiction. We continued northbound on Franklin Turnpike, until the vehicle made a right-hand turn onto Lake Street.

The vehicle then continued east on Lake Street until it made a right-hand turn onto the on ramp to Route 17 South. While attempting to negotiate the curve at a high rate of speed, the vehicle struck the curb causing the two front tires to rupture. The vehicle then jumped the curb median and continued the wrong way on the off-ramp to Route 17 South. We observed the vehicle as we continued on the onramp to Route 17 South. See RPD PO. Finn's NJTR1 report (Case number 24-10736.) Myself and RPD PO. Christopher Finn #171 were behind the disabled vehicle as it continued southbound on Route 17 South for approximately 300 feet. The vehicle came to a stop and PO. Finn and I tactically positioned our vehicles to conduct a Felony Stop. We both exited our vehicles and held the Operator, Mr. Kahlil Eccleston, at gunpoint while we gave him commands to exit the vehicle with his hands up. I instructed the party to walk backwards away from his vehicle. I then placed him under arrest, and searched him incident to arrest, which provided negative results.

Ramsey PD Officers cleared the vehicle. I requested CO. Marino to dispatch a duty tow to the scene for a vehicle impound. I then secured Mr. Eccleston in the rear prisoner compartment of unit 219. PO. Dimitri Forde #255 completed the impound sheet for the vehicle. Venusti Towing arrived on scene. I transported Mr. Eccleston to police headquarters. My starting mileage was 6,263, and my ending mileage was 6,266. Once secured in the sally port, I placed my firearm, three magazines, two knives, and OC Spray in the lock box. I read Mr. Eccleston his Miranda Rights to which he stated he understood and signed the form. PO. Forde fingerprinted Mr. Eccleston while I generated the complaint summons. I charged Mr. Eccleston with 1 count of Knowingly Exhibiting a False Gov issued DL/ OTR ID N.J.S. 2C:21-2.1C, and one count of Resisting Arrest/ Eluding After Instructed to Stop Motor Vehicle N.J.S. 2C:29-2B.

I contacted the BCPO Complaint Hotline after running the preliminary PSA and I spoke with AP Kasey O'Connor. I explained all relevant facts of the case and advised him based on the PSA it was a recommended summons. After reviewing the information with him, he advised that he approved the charges to be placed complaint summons.

Mr. Eccleston was served with all motor vehicle summons and criminal complaint summons. I advised him of the mandatory CJP court date of May 24, 2024 at 0800 hrs, in Hackensack. He was also advised of the Allendale Municipal Court date of June 18, 2024 at 1700 hrs for the Title 39 violations. He was also served with multiple summons issued by RPD PO. Finn and advised of the mandatory Ramsey Municipal Court date. He was then released into the headquarters lobby to await a ride.

The Pennsylvania registration was placed in evidence bag #11515529, and entered into the BEAST. I then placed the evidence into temporary evidence locker #4.

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I completed a Use Of Force (Pursuit) and Show of Force report in Benchmark. The Arrest Report, Tow Report, and Use of Force Report were all added to the case jacket. Photos of the fictitious plate and vehicle were uploaded to digital media.

On the above date and time I, PO Warbrick #258, was driving northbound in marked patrol vehicle #210 on West Crescent Avenue and stopped at the intersection at Franklin Turnpike. While waiting at the red light, I observed a group of 15-20 electric bike riders travel southbound on Franklin Turnpike. I estimated the group to be traveling above 20 mph, and the group of bikers was not yielding to traffic. I turned right onto Franklin Turnpike and was behind the group.

While behind the group, I observed the vehicles traveling above the 20 mph speed restriction for electric bikes. None of the vehicles I observed had registrations affixed to them. Members of the group were also going back and forth across the double yellow line. Due to the above-listed offenses, I initiated a motor vehicle stop at the intersection of Franklin Turnpike and Pittis Avenue due to my belief that the group posed an imminent threat to the safety of the public as they were approaching the downtown area of Allendale and driving in a reckless manner.

I activated my overhead red and blue lights as well as my siren. My in-car camera was activated at this time. No members of the group yielded and continued traveling at approximately 40 mph southbound on Franklin Turnpike. I requested PO Rubino #251 to respond to my location.

Some members yielded in front of 290 Franklin Turnpike, and I stopped my vehicle ahead of them and exited my patrol vehicle. Several of the riders continued past my vehicle, but I instructed the 8 riders behind me to stop. My body-worn camera was activated at this time.

They asked what they had done wrong, and I explained the numerous offenses they committed. I requested their identification and the parties slowly complied. I took the 7 driver's licenses I was provided and forwarded them to dispatch to check each party for wants and warrants. One party, who identified themselves as David Rivera, stated he did not have his identification on him. He stated he had no photo of his license. He provided his date of birth and address. I forwarded that information to dispatch who was unable to locate a driver's license or ID. CO LoPrinzi contacted Rockland County dispatch for assistance, and they were also unable to obtain a driver's license or ID for the individual.

I returned to the group and stated we would be issuing warnings to the group and advised them to ride at the 20 mph speed restriction and on the right side of the roadway. I handed each license I was given back to the group and told them they were free to go. I instructed that if they wanted to wait, they could do so on West Orchard which is currently closed to vehicular traffic. I informed David Rivera that he was not free to leave until I could identify him.

David pushed his bike towards West Orchard and I followed behind on foot. David then deactivated his lights on the electric bike, mounted the electric bike and took off. I entered my patrol vehicle and followed David with my lights activated.

David took the first right turn onto Chestnut Street and then the first right onto Erol Court. David's speed was approximately 40 mph and he continued to the cul-de-sac at the end of Erol Court. PO Rubino left the group at 290 Franklin Turnpike and followed me onto Erol Court.

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David then rode across several lawns, evading me and turned right back onto Chestnut Street. At this time PO Rubino stated we were in pursuit of the electric bike due to imminent public safety hazard David posed as well as the eluding and obstruction. PO Rubino requested dispatch to notify Waldwick of such. PO Rubino and I continued down Chestnut Street, which turned into Hopper Avenue. There was no traffic, and speeds were approximately 50 mph. The pavement was dry, and the night was clear.

David failed to stop at the stop sign located West Prospect Street and continued on Hopper Avenue. David then made a right turn onto Wyckoff Avenue while ignoring a red light. PO Rubino and I continued behind the electric bike and David then made a left turn onto John Dow Avenue. Traffic continued to be light or nonexistent. David then made the left turn on Crescent Ave which turned into Prospect Street in Midland Park. Midland Park was notified of such.

David, who continued to ride at approximately 40-50 mph, turned right onto Fairhaven Drive. I signaled to PO Rubino that we should stop pursuing, and PO Rubino stated over the radio we were terminating the pursuit. I turned off my overhead lights and traveled back down Prospect Street towards Waldwick/Allendale.

PO Rubino advised that David had jumped off his bike on Englishman Drive in Midland Park. I responded to that location and found the bike laying beside 10 Englishman Drive. I secured the bike by my patrol car along with the cell phone and keys that were attached to the electric bike. Midland Park PD, Waldwick PD and PO Rubino checked the area with negative results for David.

I requested a tow to impound the vehicle. Dispatch advised that the tow had a 15-20 minute ETA. PO Rubino and I deactivated our cameras at that point. All Points Towing arrived on scene and secured the electric bike, which was then transported to the Allendale Police Department and secured in the Sally port. CO LoPrinzi checked the serial number on the bike in NCIC and found no results for the bike being stolen.

Det. Rosado was notified and he advised to secure the phone and bike and await a warrant to search anything.

Recovered items were logged into the BEAST. The suspect's cellphone was plugged into a power source and wrapped in foil to keep it secure. The phone was placed in temporary evidence locker #5. The electric bike was tagged with a BEAST label and left in the Sally port.

Motor Vehicle Pursuit form was submitted via Benchmark.

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I Det. Rosado reviewed the case and determined there was not enough probable cause to search the bike. I called Big Tows Ramsey to impound the vehicle a search of inventory was conducted and documented on the tow sheet.

The cellphone and air tag were moved to storage locker 16 for safekeeping waiting for the owner to come pick up his devices. No notification was made due to there being no information from the initial motor vehicle stop.

 On the above date and time, I, PO. Rubino #251 was requested by PO. Warbrick #258 to assist on a motor vehicle traffic stop. PO. Warbrick advised that he was with multiple operators on electric bicycles and scooters. In marked unit #216, I responded to his location, 290 Franklin Turnpike. I activated unit #216 overhead warning lights and my body-worn camera. PO. Warbrick explained to me he observed a group of riders, approximately 15-20 of them, traveling over the 20 mph speed restriction for electric bikes. He also stated to me that the riders were crossing the double yellow line multiple times, and none of the bikes had registration affixed to them. He conducted a motor vehicle stop at Franklin Turnpike South and Pittis Ave. However, the riders did not yield to him and continued on Franklin Turnpike South, traveling over 40 mph.

PO. Warbrick said 8 riders stopped before Allendale Police Headquarters while some continued south on Franklin Turnpike. PO. Warbrick collected 7 driver's licenses, except one of the riders had no proof of identification. The rider said he had an ID card and was named David Rivera. CO. LoPrinzi attempted to search for the individual by name and date of birth. However, there was no record found. David said that he did not know his social security number either. I instructed CO. LoPrinzi to contact Rockland County Communications to assist with the MNI search for David, and they, too, did not receive anything on record. PO. Warbrick and I decided to issue warnings to the riders who stopped and would be attempting to identify David further.

PO Warbrick instructed David to pull out of the travel lane onto West Orchard Street for safety. Upon returning to my vehicle, I observed marked unit #210 operated by PO. Warbrick take off south on to Franklin Turnpike. I followed unit #210 right onto Chestnut Street and right onto Erol Court. I observed PO. Warbrick following David on his E-Bike, who I observed driving on the front lawns of numerous homes and continuing back towards Chestnut Street. David made a right onto Chestnut Street, ignoring our unit's lights and sirens. He then proceeded south toward Hopper Ave into Waldwick. I advised CO. LoPrinzi that we were initiating a pursuit and to notify Waldwick for their assistance. I gave dispatch my current speed and direction of the pursuit. I also gave dispatch a description of the operator and the E-Bike. David continued across West Prospect Street south toward Wyckoff Ave. David then proceeded through the red traffic signal at Wyckoff Ave and Hopper Ave, turning left West onto Wyckoff Ave. David then turned right onto John Dow Ave south and continued toward Crescent Ave.

I advised CO. LoPrinzi to update Midland Park and Wyckoff that we were heading toward their jurisdiction. David made a left turn South onto Crescent Ave and then a right onto Fairhaven Drive West, continuing to travel at 40-50 mph speeds. PO. Warbrick signaled to me that we should terminate the pursuit. I radioed to dispatch that we were terminating the pursuit. I continued to observe David travel south on Park Ave to await the arrival of Midland Park Police and to give dispatch an accurate location for other responding agencies. While I was updating dispatch, David continued south on Park Ave into a dead-end street adjacent to Midland Park's Borough Park. He then proceeded down a bike path, where I observed him enter the rear property of 10 Englishmen Drive. I told dispatch that the suspect had exited his bike and where his current location was.

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I exited my patrol car and observed David running into the woods behind 10 Englishmen Drive. I removed my service weapon from its holster and, as a show of force, pointed it at David and told him to get on the ground numerous times. I radioed to dispatch that I had one suspect at gunpoint. David then jumped into a creek behind 10 Englishmen Drive and swam across to the other side. I immediately re-holstered my weapon and returned to my vehicle. Midland Park units arrived to assist with apprehending David. I advised the responding units where he went. Waldwick and Wyckoff's units assisted with the search; however, David was not located after swimming out of the creek. I advised PO. Warbrick to respond to my location to secure the E-Bike for impound. A1 Towing was the on-call duty wrecker. During the pursuit, I advised CO. LoPrinzi to notify Lt. Griffith #226 since Sgt. Helmer #248 was out of the state.

I also telephonically called Detective Rosado #257 and advised him of the situation. Once back at headquarters with the bike, I had CO. LoPrinzi run an NCIC check with the serial number provided on the bike. However, he was not able to get a return. Personal items recovered at the scene were logged into the BEAST by PO. Warbrick. I submitted a Show of Force report to Benchmark and PO. Warbrick submitted a pursuit report to Benchmark as well. No further police action was taken.
