Incident Report



On Thursday, April 11, 2024 at approximately 1710 hours, a BOLO was put out by Westwood Police Dispatch for a male party driving a dirt bike erratically and not wearing a helmet. Officer John Svenda was on motor patrol in Truck 8, stationed in the parking lot of St. Andrew's Church. Officer Svenda observed a male party traveling west on Washington Avenue riding a blue dirt bike with a mask on and not wearing a helmet. Officer Svenda pulled behind the vehicle and initiated his lights and sirens to effect a motor vehicle stop. The vehicle did not make any attempt to stop. Officer Svenda continued behind the vehicle west bound on Washington Avenue into Washington Township. There was no pedestrian traffic but there was heavy vehicle traffic. At this time, Officer Svenda observed the vehicle first swerve to the right and improperly pass traffic, then swerve back to the left of traffic crossing over the double yellow line numerous times. Due to it raining and the road being wet and concerns for officer and pedestrian safety, Sgt. Dean McCarroll advised Officer Svenda to terminate the pursuit of the vehicle. A black Chevy SUV was attempting to turn left onto Chestnut Street when the dirt bike, who was driving on the opposite side of traffic, attempted to pass the Chevy on its left side. The Chevy then collided into the dirt bike and ran over the driver. Officer Svenda notified Westwood dispatch via radio of the motor vehicle accident and advised them to notify Washington Township Police.

The driver of the dirt bike, Mr. Michael D. Rivero Gularte, refused medical attention at the scene. The motor vehicle accident was turned over to the Washington Township Police Department (see report #24-003746). Mr. Rivero Gularte was subsequently placed under arrest, searched for weapons, contraband, evidence and implements of escape, as was the area under that individual's immediate control. After being restrained and searched, the arrestee was secured in the rear of Westwood Patrol Unit 8 equipped with a partition between the front and rear passengers' compartments. The rear seat of Unit 8 was checked at the beginning of the shift and prior to occupation by the prisoner. Mr. Rivero Gularte was then transported directly to the Westwood Police Department. Upon arrival, Officer Svenda secured his weapon in the weapon's locker and escorted Mr. Rivero Gularte into the booking area. He was then processed and photographed as per department policy by Officer Svenda.

At the conclusion of this event, Mr. Rivero Gularte was charged on summons 0267-S-2024-000032 with:

On Saturday, August 24th, 2024 at approximately 1404 hours, I, Officer Jose Nieves, was watching traffic at the intersection of Center Avenue and Jefferson Avenue, and a silver vehicle bearing New Jersey registration B37SAV caught my attention.

The vehicle had no front plate, no inspection sticker, and the front windshield was tinted. I pulled behind it and followed it down Jefferson Avenue. While stopped at the traffic signal I entered the New Jersey registration in NCIC. The registration came back to a 2012 Acura out of Paterson, New Jersey. The vehicle that was in front of me was a silver Honda Accord.

The vehicle made a right hand turn onto Broadway. Once safe, I activated my emergency lights and sirens to initiate a motor vehicle stop. While calling out my location I noticed furtive movement in the vehicle while it pulled over. Seconds later the vehicle drove off recklessly heading North on Broadway until it came to the intersection of Westwood Avenue and Washington Avenue. That's when the vehicle turned left onto Washington Avenue heading West without using their turn indicator. The vehicle then continued west on Washington Avenue traveling at a high rate of speed. I safely merged into traffic and turned on to Washington Avenue. Due to the heavy traffic and the risk to civilians and myself I turned off my lights and sirens to terminate the pursuit. Sergeant Sean Roche, the tour supervisor, radioed my patrol unit to advise me to terminate the pursuit as well.

The incident was entered into the Benchmark system as per the Attorney General Guidelines. As well as vehicle description and direction reported to surrounding jurisdictions.

No accidents occurred during pursuit.

The registration comes back to 2012 Grey Acura, but the vehicle from the incident was a Silver Honda Accord.

I contacted the registered owner of B37SAV Jazleen Garcia-Delacruz who informed me that she no longer owned the vehicle associated with that plate. She stated she did not know what happened to the plates, but she did not recall turning them into New Jersey DMV. She informed me she would like to report that plate stolen and she did not know who was currently in possession of it.

I entered B37SAV into NCIC as a stolen license plate, and I sent out a TRAKS message to the surrounding areas attempting to identify the vehicle / occupant(s).

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Supplemental Investigation Report



On March 3, 2025, at approximately 0951 hours, I Detective Joseph Pavone was contacted by Deputy Gully of the Seminole County Sheriff's Department in Florida. Deputy Gully explained that he had a vehicle stopped bearing New Jersey Registration B37SAV, which the registration was reported stolen by the registered owner Jazleen Garcia-Delacruz after a vehicle eluded Officer Nieves while he attempted a motor vehicle stop on 8/24/2024. Deputy Gully informed me that he had a male party under arrest for driving without a license who claimed the vehicle and the plate belonged to his girlfriend Jazleen Garcia-Delacruz. A short time later Jazleen arrived on scene and claimed ownership of the vehicle and the registration, and when Deputy Gully asked her why she reported it stolen if her boyfriend had it Jazleen refused to answer and began crying. This incident was recorded on Deputy Gully's Body Camera, which along with a copy of the arrest report will be requested and submitted to Records.

I contacted Assistant Prosecutor Sara Wilson and advised her of the incident, and she approved charging Jazleen Garcia-Delacruz with filing a false police report.

On Wednesday June 19th, 2024, I, Officer Ryan Sestanovich was conducting a motor vehicle crash investigation at the intersection of Washington Avenue and Trenton Avenue.

While completing my investigation my attention was drawn to a Black motorcycle because I observed it cross over the double yellow line and improperly pass a vehicle traveling east on Washington Avenue. I entered my patrol vehicle and proceeded after the motorcycle to effect a motor vehicle stop. While closing the gap I utilized the patrol vehicle's lights and sirens.

Once directly behind the motorcycle at the intersection of Washington Avenue and Third Avenue I determined that the motorcycle's registration was completely obstructed and unrecognizable. The motorcycle appeared to be operated by a male driver wearing a dark colored shirt and a white helmet and female rear passenger wearing a black and orange helmet, green tank top and gray shorts. The operator of the motorcycle proceeded to pass another vehicle on the left and make a right turn onto Broadway southbound. The motorcycle proceeded to accelerate at a high rate of speed south on Broadway and onto Old Hook Road Extension. I notified Westwood Communications that a motorcycle failed to stop for me, turned off my police lights and sirens and turned on Jefferson Avenue and notified them that I was not in pursuit of the motorcycle.

The New Jersey Attorney General's Vehicle Pursuit report was completed as per department policy.

On Saturday, August 9, 2025, at approximately 16:21 hours, I, Officer Alex Dinardi, was assigned to Motor Patrol in the Borough of Westwood. While on routine patrol, I observed a gray dirt bike traveling southbound on Kinderkamack Road near Westwood Avenue, stopped for the red traffic signal. The dirt bike was occupied by two males, neither wearing a helmet. The vehicle was not equipped with mirrors and was positioned unsafely between two lanes of traffic.

When the traffic light turned green at the intersection, the dirt bike proceeded south on Kinderkamack Road. I activated my emergency lights to make a U-turn and initiate a motor vehicle stop. I caught up to the dirt bike near Kinderkamack Road and Jefferson Avenue. I contacted Westwood Dispatch via radio to advise of the motor vehicle stop. The dirt bike failed to stop or yield and continued southbound at a high rate of speed.

Upon reaching Kinderkamack Road and Kingsberry Avenue, I informed Westwood Police Dispatch that I was still attempting to stop the vehicle, which continued south on Kinderkamack Road. I observed the dirt bike cross over the double yellow lines and pass multiple vehicles. After approximately two blocks, at Green Avenue, I terminated the stop due to safety concerns. I deactivated my emergency lights and siren and continued to travel in the same direction at a safe speed. I eventually lost sight of the dirt bike and returned to the Borough of Westwood.

Vehicle description and direction was reported to surrounding jurisdictions.

All relevant evidence, will be forwarded to the Westwood Police Detective Bureau for follow-up investigations. The incident was entered into the Benchmark system as per policy and Attorney General Guidelines.
