I responded to Victoria's Secret on a report of a dispute. Upon my arrival I spoke with the caller, [REDACTED], who stated that she was next to a woman who asked her to move six feet away and that the woman started videotaping her which caused her to go into a panic attack at which time she followed her to get her to stop videotaping her. [REDACTED] says that she has an anxiety disorder. After speaking to [REDACTED] I proceeded to go inside the store and speak to the other involved person, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] states that she was over at a display looking at some items when [REDACTED] walked over to where she was. She states that [REDACTED] selected an item and was close to her at which point she asked her to back up. According to [REDACTED], [REDACTED] then went over to the cashiers and wanted [REDACTED] thrown out of the store because she threatened her and was videotaping her. She, [REDACTED]...

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[REDACTED] states that as she was videotaping, [REDACTED] lunged at her and tried to assault her. [REDACTED] states that she only started videotaping because of the way [REDACTED] was acting and wanted to protect herself from false accusations. [REDACTED] showed me video of [REDACTED] on the floor in front of the cashiers desk crying and also shows [REDACTED] lunging toward her. After speaking with [REDACTED] I proceeded to speak with store manager [REDACTED] and sales associate [REDACTED]

I was speaking with [REDACTED] and she stated that she didn't witness the initial incident but that [REDACTED] had. [REDACTED] corroborated what [REDACTED] had told me, that [REDACTED] did ask [REDACTED] to back up and that [REDACTED] did not threaten [REDACTED] at all. She states that when [REDACTED] went over to the cashiers and made the comment that she had been threatened. [REDACTED] said she was going to videotape to protect herself. At one point according to [REDACTED], [REDACTED] was on the floor crying and very upset. [REDACTED] stated she thought she may be having some type of medical issue.

After speaking with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] I went back to [REDACTED] to speak with her. [REDACTED] commented that she wanted her, [REDACTED], charged. I advised her of the procedure for signing a complaint if she wished to do so. [REDACTED] then stated that she wanted [REDACTED] removed from the Mall because she had more shopping to do and felt threatened. I advised her that I could not kick her out of the Mall because I do not work for the Mall but that we could follow her, [REDACTED], to her vehicle if she felt threatened. [REDACTED] was not happy with this and expressed her view that if roles were reversed she would be kicked out of the Mall. [REDACTED] then started to videotape again. At this time I went back outside the store to speak with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] followed and continued to videotape.

I spoke with [REDACTED] and advised her that I spoke with store employees and that they corroborated what [REDACTED] had said happened. [REDACTED] seemed to acknowledge that she was wrong, saying she was concerned about losing her job and apartment if the video is posted online and that she was having a panic attack about the videotaping. I advised her that [REDACTED] has a right to videotape. I asked her several times if she was alright and if she needed an ambulance and she declined repeatedly. She kept expressing her concern about her job and apartment. She finally stated that she was going home and I asked if she would be okay to drive and she says she was. At this time [REDACTED] left the Mall voluntarily with Mall security Sgt. Clarence Culler #S4 escorting her. I then walked over to [REDACTED] and again advised her of the procedure for signing a complaint with the court and asked her to email me her video of the incident so I could submit it with the report and she stated she would. I also gave her the case number as well. At this time myself and P.O. Ford left the scene.
