TITLE: JACQUELIN KERRIGAN ET AL, DISTRIBUTOR OF CDS

ACTIVITY: SURVEILLANCE/ARREST

DATE OF REPORT: APRIL 18, 2019

SYNOPSIS:

The following report will detail this writer's participation in the surveillance and subsequent arrests of Jacquelin Kerrigan, Cathleen Turi, Stacy Fredericks and Gerard Straniero for CDS related offenses.

DETAILS:

On April 18 2019, this writer along with other members of the Toms River Police Department Special Enforcement Team were conducting surveillance in the parking lot of the Walmart, located at 950 Route 37 West, in Toms River. This location is known to this writer as being an area of high narcotic activity and where numerous CDS related arrests have been made. During the surveillance, this writer along with Detective MacRae observed a green 2002 Nissan Altima, bearing New Jersey registration H21-HUR parked next to a white 2009 Honda Civic, bearing New Jersey registration Z38-FLH. This writer observed the driver of the Altima, later identified as Jacquelin Kerrigan approach the passenger side of the Civic.

The vehicles were parked away from the business and away from other vehicles. At this time other members of the TRPD/SET were advised of our observations and converged on the area.

A short time later, a white 2011 Toyota Camry, bearing New Jersey registration W48-DPB pull alongside the aforementioned Altima. This writer observed Kerrigan approach the driver of the Camry, later identified as Stacy Fredericks. This writer observed Kerrigan take money from the driver of the Camry which she concealed in her bra. Kerrigan walked over to the Civic where she exchanged items with the passenger, later identified as Cathleen Turi. Kerrigan returned to the Camry where she handed the driver items. Based on this writers training and experience, this activity is consistent with the sale and purchase of CDS. It was determined that members of the TRPD/SET would make contact with the individuals.

Members of the TRPD/SET approached the vehicles and made contact with Kerrigan who was standing outside her vehicle, Fredericks who was sitting in her vehicle, and Turi who was sitting in her vehicle along with Gerard Straniero sitting in

arrest. She stated she purchased the pills from Kerrigan. She further added Kerrigan got the pills from Turi and Straniero.

At this time, a search was conducted on all three vehicles. The following items were seized. In Fredericks Camry, 37 orange pills, identified as Diazepam where located. In Turi and Straniero's Honda Civic, a prescription bottle containing 38.5 Diazepam pills were located. In Kerrigan's Nissan Altima, 4 orange pills identified as Diazepam, 8 white pills identified as Clonazepam, one yellow pill identified as Oxycodone Hydrochloride and 3 blue pills identified as Clonazepam where located. Additionally, \$372.00 in assorted US currency was seized from Turi and Kerrigan.

All four individuals were placed under arrest and transported to District One without incident. Once back at District One, Cathleen Turi agreed to provide a taped statement.

STATEMENT OF CATHLEEN TURI

In the presence of Patrolman Seaman, Cathleen Turi was read her Miranda Rights by Detective MacRae and she was presented with a rights waiver form. Turi signed the rights waiver form and agreed to make a statement. During her statement, Turi implicated herself and Kerrigan for distributing pills. See the taped statement for further details.

At the conclusion of the investigation, Jacquelin Kerrigan was charged with possession of Diazepam, distribution of Diazepam, possession of Clonazepam and Possession of Oxycodone Hydrochloride, she was released on a summons. Cathleen Turi was charged with distribution of Diazepam, she was released on a summons. Gerard Straniero was charged with distribution of Diazepam, he was released on a summons. Stacy Fredericks was charged with possession of Diazepam, she was released on a summons.

Upon returning to TRPD Headquarters all the evidence that seized was dated, packaged, sealed and placed into the evidence locker pending transportation to the Ocean County CIU lab for analysis and the TRPD evidence room.
