We learned today that there was a fire suppression system test at a private development which seems to have resulted in a large volume of water flowing through the water system in a short period of time. It seems that that may have caused some water discoloration for some residents which should clear up by running the water in the household. Had we known about this beforehand, we may have been able to predict this would occur and could have notified residents in advance. If anyone contacts you, they can be advised of same and should be instructed to just run the water until it is clear.
