Purpose: This Affidavit/Certification is to more fully describe the facts of the alleged offense so that a judge or authorized judicial officer may determine probable cause.

1. Description of relevant facts and circumstances which support probable cause that (1) the offense(s) was committed and (2) the defendant is the one who committed it:

On Thursday, February 20, 2020, at approximately 4:54 PM, the Keansburg Police Department received a call reporting a dispute between persons outside in the area of 69 Seabreeze Way followed by the sound of three gunshots. Upon arrival, officers observed two spent shell casings on the street, one in front of 77 Seabreeze Way and one in front of 73 Seabreeze Way. Both shells were stamped "RP 380." Officers also observed damage to the front of 69/71 Seabreeze Way consistent with a bullet striking the siding of the location.

17-year-old juvenile victim Z.H., reported that he had just exited his mother's house and was walking on Seabreeze Way when he heard a car engine revving, which caused him to run back towards the house. Z.H. reported hearing loud popping noises but denied seeing anything. The bullet that struck 69 Seabreeze Way was not recovered due to the depth of the round into the side of the house. It should be noted that bullet was approximately 3 feet and 2 inches high, and only 2 feet to the left of where the victim had been standing at the time the shots were fired.

A child playing outside of her nearby residence described seeing two cars, both black in color, the first she described as a 4-door sedan and the second she described as either an SUV or minivan. She stated the cars appeared to have had an accident and she described both drivers of each vehicle as African American females. She stated the two females appeared to have an argument before both cars drove off at a high rate of speed. As they were driving away, the child heard (3) loud popping sounds.

Further investigation led to video surveillance from that date showing a dark colored Lexus RX-350 driving south on Seabreeze Way passing 69 and proceeding to the corner of Highland Avenue, making a U-turn and then proceeding north on Seabreeze Way to pull into a parking spot in front of 53 Seabreeze Way. That SUV was later identified through investigation as belonging to the registered owner, Brittany Smalls. Subsequently a black 4-door Honda turns right onto Seabreeze Way from Highland Ave., driving north on Seabreeze Way, aggressively pulling to the right in front of the Lexus and blocking its path. A female later identified as Smalls' girlfriend, A.B. exited the car, which appeared to be a newer model Honda Accord. As A.B. exits, the Lexus began to back up, causing the female to return to the driver seat of the Honda and attempt to block the street further.

Another camera shows the victim Z.H. dressed in a dark sweatshirt exiting from an area near 69 Seabreeze Way. At that moment, the Lexus manages to pass the Honda, speeding down the block. The video shows Z.H. alert to the speeding car, and Z.H. begins to run back towards 69 Seabreeze Way. As the Lexus speeds down the block, the rear window opens and an arm comes out of the window, shooting in the direction of Z.H.

Additional video surveillance from 14 Highland Ave from that date and time right before the shooting occurs shows Wayne Jones, Jr., who resides in that apartment complex, holding his right hand close to his waist area and entering the rear passenger door of the Lexus. As he does so, a 2006 Volkswagen SUV owned by Wayne's stepmother K.S. pulls up alongside the Lexus. There appears to be a brief conversation before the Lexus speeds off.

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Additional video surveillance from 14 Highland Ave from that date and time right before the shooting occurs shows Wayne Jones, Jr., who resides in that apartment complex, holding his right hand close to his waist area and entering the rear passenger door of the Lexus. As he does so, a 2006 Volkswagen SUV owned by Wayne's stepmother K.S. pulls up alongside the Lexus. There appears to be a brief conversation before the Lexus speeds off.

In speaking with K.S. about that interaction, she refused to provide a formal statement but confirmed she spoke with her stepson Wayne Jones, Jr., on that date, and observed Tyrone Bailey and Brittany Smith in the vehicle with Jones, Jr. before they drove away.

On March 5, 2020, Brittany Smalls provided a video recorded statement confirming her presence on Seabreeze Way on February 20, 2020. Smalls confirmed she was involved in a dispute with her girlfriend A.B. Smalls confirmed that she was driving the vehicle, that Tyrone Bailey was in the front passenger seat, and that Wayne Jones Jr was in the rear passenger seat behind Bailey. She reiterated that there was no one else in the car. Smalls denied any knowledge of the shooting, or the object pointing out of the back of her vehicle at the precise time that Z.H. was shot at.

Brittany Smalls, Wayne Jones, Jr., and Tyrone Bailey are reported members of the Hoover set of the Crips criminal street gang. The victim Z.H. is a reported member of the Neighborhood 20's set of the Blood criminal street gang. Two weeks prior to the shooting, Keansburg Police Department received a report from M.M., who indicated Tyrone Bailey and Wayne Jones, Jr. assaulted M.M. on the street in order to force him to provide the whereabouts of another Blood member and close acquaintance of Z.H. M.M. reported that Bailey and Jones referenced a handgun during that assault.

On May 6, 2020, Jones was apprehended in a vehicle with two other individuals. In their joint possession was a loaded 9 millimeter handgun. Upon his arrest, Jones, Jr. provided a video recorded statement denying shooting at the Z.H. on February 20, 2020. He did confirm, however, that he was in Keansburg with Brittany Smalls on the date she got in an altercation with her girlfriend. Jones, Jr. also confirmed knowing the victim by his street name, and reported that he had a prior issue with the victim threatening him with a gun approximately two years ago.

As A.B. exits, the Lexus began to back up, causing the female to return to the driver seat of the Honda and attempt to block the street further.

Another camera shows the victim Z.H. dressed in a dark sweatshirt exiting from an area near 69 Seabreeze Way. At that moment, the Lexus manages to pass the Honda, speeding down the block. The video shows Z.H. alert to the speeding car, and Z.H. begins to run back towards 69 Seabreeze Way. As the Lexus speeds down the block, the rear window opens and an arm comes out of the window, shooting in the direction of Z.H.

Additional video surveillance from 14 Highland Ave from that date and time right before the shooting occurs shows Wayne Jones, Jr., who resides in that apartment complex, holding his right hand close to his waist area and entering the rear passenger door of the Lexus. As he does so, a 2006 Volkswagen SUV owned by Wayne's stepmother K.S. pulls up alongside the Lexus. There appears to be a brief conversation before the Lexus speeds off.

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In speaking with K.S. about that interaction, she refused to provide a formal statement but confirmed she spoke with her stepson Wayne Jones, Jr., on that date, and observed Tyrone Bailey and Brittany Smith in the vehicle with Jones, Jr. before they drove away.

On March 5, 2020, Brittany Smalls provided a video recorded statement confirming her presence on Seabreeze Way on February 20, 2020. Smalls confirmed she was involved in a dispute with her girlfriend A.B. Smalls confirmed that she was driving the vehicle, that Tyrone Bailey was in the front passenger seat, and that Wayne Jones Jr was in the rear passenger seat behind Bailey. She reiterated that there was no one else in the car. Smalls denied any knowledge of the shooting, or the object pointing out of the back of her vehicle at the precise time that Z.H. was shot at.

Brittany Smalls, Wayne Jones, Jr., and Tyrone Bailey are reported members of the Hoover set of the Crips criminal street gang. The victim Z.H. is a reported member of the Neighborhood 20's set of the Blood criminal street gang. Two weeks prior to the shooting, Keansburg Police Department received a report from M.M., who indicated Tyrone Bailey and Wayne Jones, Jr. assaulted M.M. on the street in order to force him to provide the whereabouts of another Blood member and close acquaintance of Z.H. M.M. reported that Bailey and Jones referenced a handgun during that assault.

On May 6, 2020, Jones was apprehended in a vehicle with two other individuals. In their joint possession was a loaded 9 millimeter handgun. Upon his arrest, Jones, Jr. provided a video recorded statement denying shooting at the Z.H. on February 20, 2020. He did confirm, however, that he was in Keansburg with Brittany Smalls on the date she got in an altercation with her girlfriend. Jones, Jr. also confirmed knowing the victim by his street name, and reported that he had a prior issue with the victim threatening him with a gun approximately two years ago.
