RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN MOU BETWEEN THE CITY OF WILDWOOD AND THE BOROUGH OF WEST WILDWOOD TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY POLICE SERVICES FOR A FIXED TERM TO BE DETERMINED

WHEREAS, the Borough of West Wildwood is in need of temporary police services to provide routine patrol assignments in their Borough to accommodate a current police shortage while perspective officers are attending the police academy to receive certification; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wildwood Police Department is willing, appropriately positioned, and is capable of providing the emergency, short-term, police services to its neighboring community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wildwood Police Department has agreed to provide the services of a Class II Officer for patrol assignments to the Borough of West Wildwood from 7pm to 7am beginning Monday, September 19, 2022 for a fixed term to be determined, and

WHEREAS, the Borough of West Wildwood has agreed to pay the City of Wildwood the Class II Officer special assignment rate of \$55.00 per hour;

WHEREAS, said officers assigned to patrol the Borough of West Wildwood will be solely under the direct command and control of the Wildwood Police Department Command Staff and Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, due to its urgency, the complete details, and terms and conditions of the agreement between the City of Wildwood and the Borough of West Wildwood will be codified with a forthcoming MOU to be approved by the City of Wildwood at its September 28, 2022 Regular Commission Meeting,

WHEREAS, the Borough of West Wildwood will additionally approve a corresponding Resolution as well as authorize an MOU at an upcoming Regular Borough Commission meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Wildwood, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey, that it hereby authorizes the Mayor to sign an MOU between the City of Wildwood and the Borough of West Wildwood to provide emergency police services for a fixed term to be determined;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, it is understood that the terms and conditions of the approved MOU will be retroactively initiated to September 14, 2022.

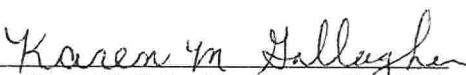

WHEREAS, the City of Wildwood Police Department is willing, appropriately positioned and is capable of providing the emergency, short-term police services to its neighboring community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wildwood Police Department has agreed to provide the services of a Class II Officer for patrol assignments to the Borough of West Wildwood from 7pm to 7am beginning Monday, September 19, 2022, for a term to expire on December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, due to its urgency, the complete details and terms and conditions of the agreement between the City of Wildwood and the Borough of West Wildwood will be codified with a forthcoming MOU to be approved by the City of Wildwood at its September 28, 2022, Regular Commission Meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of West Wildwood will additionally approve a corresponding Resolution as well and authorize an MOU at an upcoming Regular Borough Commission meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of West Wildwood, Cape May County, State of New Jersey, that the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to sign an MOU between the City of Wildwood and the Borough of West Wildwood to provide emergency police services for a term to expire on December 31, 2022.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, it is understood that the terms and conditions of the approved MOU will be retroactively initiated to September 14, 2022.
