At approximately 2236 hours on Saturday November 23, 2024, I, Ofc. Joshua Stinson (835SPP) was patrolling the Waterford section of Wharton State Forest when I observed multiple motor vehicles in a restricted area. The area, a waterhole that is located on the side of Burnt Mills Road, had one of the Jeeps stuck in the mud while (2) other Jeeps were covered in mud and in the restricted area.

I called out the location and information I had on the stop and requested Sgt. Calloway (799SPP), Ofc. Wentzell (874SPP), and Ofc. Robinson (886SPP) to come to my location for assistance. I was able to get the NJ DLs for the (3) drivers and issued them all summonses for 7:2-3.4(a) for operation of a MV in a restricted area. Two of the vehicles were unregistered and were subsequently impounded by Bills' Towing.
